About the Workshop

In the light of above background, the Research and Publication Cell, IQAC, & Department of English, S. S. College, Hailakandi (NAAC Re-reaccredited “A” Grade), Assam has planned to organize a Five Day National Level Online Workshop on the theme “**NAAC Revised Accreditation Framework (RAF): Its relevance in the present higher education paradigm in India**”.
