TABLE Findings:

After a thorough analysis of the different parameters of the table shown above for acquiring information regarding the overall assessment of the institution by the students, it is found that in case of parameter 17 out of 18 students 17 students have expressed their absolute faith on the institution. In case of parameter 11 & 14 students have little bit reservations in giving full positive response and the response is 83% But in case of parameter like 01,09,12 students expressed their dissatisfaction on the Syllabus, Encourage students participation in classes and the approach of the teachers, the institution should take care off. In case of the other parameters set for the students' assessment, students have given positive response like "adequate', with some difficulty etc."

Action to be taken:







student survey (Feedback) overall Report 2022-2023 how much of the syllabus was covered in class














