PERSIAN

Objective:

The objective of this paper is to develop basic communication, reading and speaking skills in modern Persian. Students will continue to develop linguistic competence through a curriculum that builds upon the vocabulary and grammar introduced in **FYUG** 1st and 2nd semester. The course follows a thematically organised and integrative approach to Persian language and culture.

Learning Outcome:

By the end of the Semester 1st and 2nd student will be able to:

- This course is designed to help students develop the basic skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking Persian, while incorporating knowledge of the Persian culture. Language technologies will assist students while they learn the script and phonology of the Persian alphabet.
- Recognise and produce all major grammatical structures in modern Persian including verb and tenses.
- Speak and write on a number of basic topics related to themselves, their surroundings, daily life, recreation, travel and so on.
- Read and comprehend passages from simple but authentic texts from the Persian speaking world. Such texts might include instructions, encyclopaedia entries, reports, film and theatre scripts, and short stories among others.
- Use their linguistic competence to continue learning Persian at higher levels, through both additional language study at Persian language institutions and through reading more advanced texts with the assistance of missionaries and other reference materials.
